Mean RIT Scores by Grade

Once again, all grade levels EXCEEDED the Norm RIT scores!

The 8th grade scores are some of the highest we've had ever. "Norm RIT Value" refers to where a student, at that grade level, should be at in a "typical school" during the fall testing season. As you can see, once again, our 7th and 8th graders exceeded the Norm RIT Value of 11th graders in all three tests. Our 6th grade scores far exceeded the RIT values for their level. We are clearly not a "typical school."
